About OHSAS 18001 standard

OHSAS 18000 refers to a series of standards for Occupational HEALTH and SAFETY Management Systems. OHSAS 18001 sets requirement on occupational and health safety for employees. In addition to the OHSAS 18001 Occupational Health and Safety Management Specifications there is a guidance document known as OHSAS 18002:2000 Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems Guidelines for the implementation of OHSAS 18001.

Comply with OHSAS 18001 standard

Once you implement processes and procedures that comply with the requirements listed in the OHSAS 18001 documentation, you can be audited by a third party organization called Registrar such as TUV or UL who will certify your organization to this standard. OHSAS 18001 is GENERIC and is applicable to any type of organizations. It can also be integrated with ISO 9000 and ISO 14000 seamlessly.
